4. Environmental concerns are driving a shift towards sustainable practices and a green economy. Individuals with knowledge and skills in sustainability and renewable energy will be in high demand.



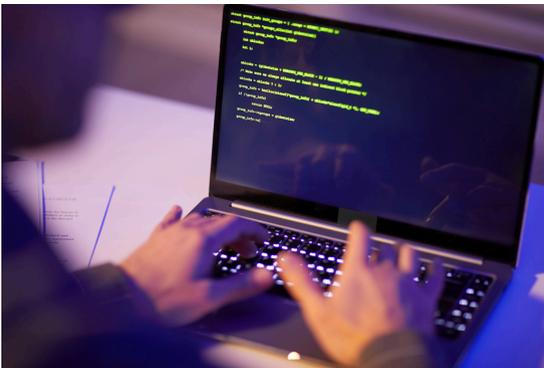

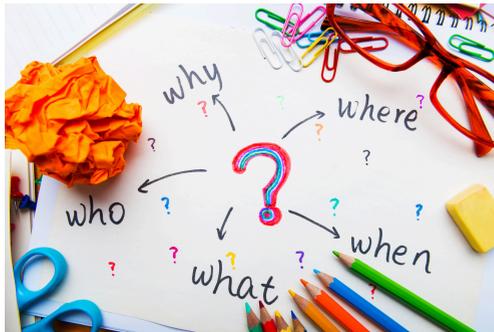
